History - the story behind our City Logistics challenge

- Unprecedented major event 204 countries
- No template to refer to or advise on only 3rd time in London 1908, 1948 then 2012
- Over 1 million visitors a day in London
- Action teams to plan over preceding 3 years led by TFL
- Forced consolidation centre system, retiming, restricted access, business access controls and additional costs.





- Restricted delivery access
- Business extended opening/closing
- Diversions and alternative delivery addresses consolidation centre controls
- Customer understanding
- Retiming operations
- Cost implications
- Urban population average 6% increase in 63 Cities by 2025

- Major event planning project initiated
- Key event manager to coordinate plan
- Work with customers and competitors
- Engage with controlling authorities
- Identify alternative ways to operate
- Think outside the box
- Manage cost and service impact
- Effective communication








If you put all the parcels we move every year end-to-end it would stretch around the UK coastline

Gnewt/TNT Timeline




