

# City Challenges & Opportunity



## The Challenges

- London Congestion Zone likely to be extended
- Air quality
- Traffic Volumes
- 3.5m vehicles into Zone (Dec 2015)
- Traffic Speed
- 14.8 mph (07:00 10:00)
- Demanding customers want flexible / convenient delivery options

## The Opportunity

- Critical Market accounts for up to 15% of all parcel deliveries
- Greater London 8.7m residents (up 7% over last 5 years)
- Significantly higher average online spending
- Higher average household income









- Congestion charge (live)
- Low Emission Zone (live)
- Ultra Low Emission zone (approved go live 2020)
- Extended Toxicity Charge (proposed for 2017)
